HARDWARE INSTALLATION

Below are basic installation steps. Because system designs vary, refer to your system's manual for additional information if needed. *NOTE:* When using an external power adapter (not included), make sure it's 5 V DC with a 1 A positive center post.






DRIVER INSTALLATION

Windows 2000/XP/Server 2003/Vista will automatically detect and install the correct driver for the Hi-Speed USB 2.0 PC Card. Confirm that your system has the lastest service pack installed, however: For XP, you should have SP1 or later; for 2000, you should have SP4 or later.

Verifying Driver Installation

- 1. On the desktop, right-click My Computer, then click "Manage" and then "Device Manager."
- Double-click the "Universal Serial Bus controllers" listing and confirm
 that the items shown below appear in the directory. NOTE: "USB
 Root Hub" may display as "USB 2.0 Root Hub" in Windows 2000.
